GENERAL INFORMATION

For reference notes.—Westbound see page 5; eastbound see page 11.

Holiday schedules.—On New Years, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas all trains operate on Sunday schedules.

Ticket Rates.—The ticket fares given herein are for tickets to be sold at station ticket office.

Limit of Tickets.—Single tickets are good only on date of sale. Going portion of regular round trip tickets good only on date of sale; return portion limited to thirty days from date of sale.

Stop-Overs.—No stop-overs allowed except on Interline tickets.

Children's Fares.—Children five years of age and under, accompanied by parent or guardian in charge, will be carried free; over five years of age and under twelve years, will be charged HALF FARE; twelve years of age and over, FULL FARE. Round trip fare for children not to be less than a single adult fare.

Redemption of Tickets.—Refunds are made by the Auditor, Aurora, Illinois, and not by ticket agents or conductors. Tickets wholly unused will be redeemed if presented by original purchaser at the fare paid. Partly used tickets will be redeemed at the difference, if any, between the value of the transportation furnished at the regular tariff fares and the fare originally paid. Special or excursion tickets sold at reduced rates, having time limit, do not entitle holder to refund.

Fare to Be Paid on Change of Destination.—If a passenger changes destination to a point beyond that to which transportation has been collected and continues trip on same train, conductor will collect as if passenger boarded at destination to which fare was paid, regardless of transportation paid to first destination.

Cash Fares paid on train will be ten cents more than the ticket rate for adults and five cents more than the half-ticket rate for children. If ticket office is not open for train taken or a reasonable opportunity for purchase of ticket is not provided, the ticket rate will be collected.

Articles Which Can Be Carried in Passenger Coaches.—Hand baggage which can be conveniently carried, such as traveling bags, suit cases, valises, telescopes, small boxes, bundles, etc.

Dogs.—Dogs will not be carried on passenger trains unless they are muzzled, and will be charged for at the regular one-way passenger rate, maximum of twenty-five (25) cents.

Lost and Found Department.—Articles found on trains and in stations are turned in to the Lost and Found Department, Wheaton, Illinois, and may be claimed there. Telephone, Wheaton 1600.

SPECIAL 10-DAY ROUND TRIP TICKETS: On sale every day, in both directions, between Chicago and all communities on the railroad. Going portion good on date of sale. Return portion honored on all trains on date of sale or any time up to midnight of tenth day following date of sale. Half fares for children.

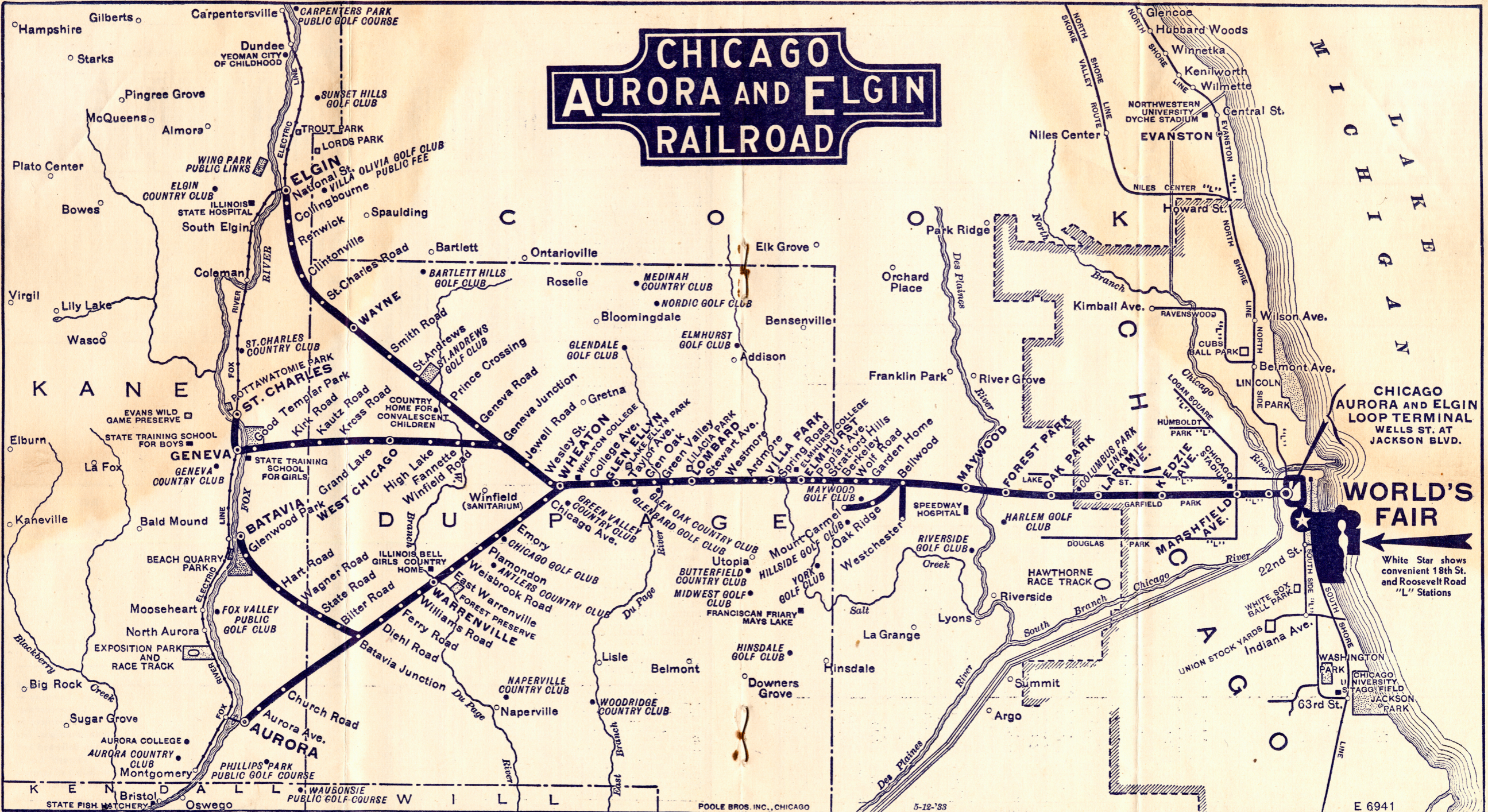
